- Images (your own, printed or cut out)

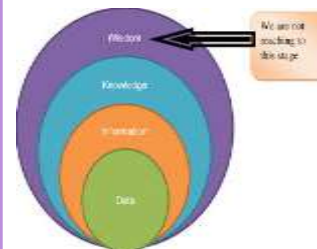


## Task 3- A meeting with God
